

Regehr, Luongo invited to Worlds camp

It didn't take too long for Steve Tambellini to roll up his sleeves and get down to work.

Just one day after Team Canada named its general manager, goaltender Roberto Luongo and defenceman Robyn Regehr told TSN that Tambellini has contacted them and invited them to training camp.

Luongo, 25, brings a wealth of international hockey experience, having participated at the World Junior Hockey Championship, World Championship and most recently, the 2004 World Cup of Hockey.

Just two years ago, Luongo was pressed into action against the Czechs during a semifinal game of the world championship in Helsinki when Sean Burke was injured and led Canada to gold. He also helped lead Canada to its second straight gold medal at the world championships last year in Prague.

Regehr 24, has also represented Canada on several occasions, playing at the World Juniors and World Cup of Hockey.

Regehr recently toured Europe with the IMG World Stars.
